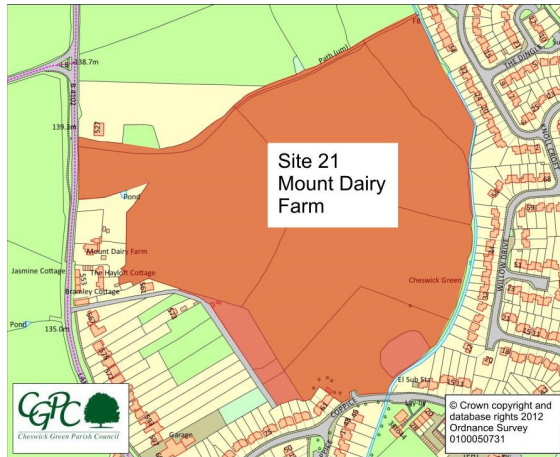
Serving the Residents of Cheswick Green and Illshaw Heath

Bloor Homes have resubmitted a planning application to build 220 houses in Cheswick Green. The proposal is almost identical to that refused in January this year, to which the Parish Council, Residents

Association and many residents objected.

However, this is a new application, and any concerns or objections **must** be made again.

The Parish Council, with the support of the Residents Association, is calling a Public Meeting on Wednesday 30th July at 7:30 pm in Cheswick Green Village Hall to discuss this application. It is hoped that Ward Councillors will be in attendance.



If you can't attend the meeting please make your views known to Solihull Council, by letter or email, whether or not you have received a letter from them.

Points previously made include:

- Development is premature
- Very seriously increased risk of flooding
- Traffic congestion and safety
- Impact on Primary and Secondary schools
- Impact on local medical services
- Land formerly a Sewage Treatment Works
- Ecological and wildlife impact
